America Award

Work and confirm 30 countries and islands of the American Continent for Class III, 35 for Class II, and over 40 for Class I. Contacts must be after 1 January 1959. One of the countries must be Cuba. KG4 is not valid.

Caribbean Award

Class I Excellent: work 30 of the 32 countries and call areas in the Caribbean including those countries with a coast on that area such as XE, VP1, TG, HR, YN, TI, HP and YV.

Class II: work 25;

Class III: work 20 Countries that have changed call signs accepted under any valid call. One of the countries

must be Cuba. KG4 is not valid, not a surprise.

Cuba Award

Work all eight Cuban call districts (CL CM CO T41 T48) from 1 to 8. Any missed district, and no more than two, may be substituted by contacting Cuban Club stations. Cuban stations must work the eight districts and cannot use substitute contacts. Club stations have three letters in the suffix. Contacts after 1 January 1959.
